Suggested itinerary :

Day 01 - Singapore / Perth

Arrive Perth and collect your Hertz rental car. Proceed to Perth and check in to your hotel.
Hit the shops in Perth e.g. Shopping centers like Myer, Westfield Carousel or Harbourtown, the factory outlet mall.
Overnight: Duxton Hotel (Deluxe Room)

Day 02 - Perth / Mandurah

Approximately 74km south of Perth, the once tiny fishing village of Mandurah is an easy hour's drive from Perth city .
Mandurah is blessed with a unique blend of coast, bushland, industry and inner-city living. A tourist's paradise, it's also the capital of the Peel region and considered the gateway to the South West.
Take a scenic canal cruise along Mandurah's magnificent waterways and find lovable Bottlenose dolphin schools. Pick up some local arts and crafts or fresh produce at one of Mandurah's markets.
Overnight: Seashells Mandurah (1bedroom Apartment / 2bedroom Apartment for 3A, 2A1C & 2A2C)

Day 03 - Mandurah - free day in Mandurah to visit the attractions near by ...

Day 04 - Mandurah / Margaret River

Head for Bunbury to enjoy some wines from the Geographe Wine Region. Enjoy lunch at one of the many Bunbury cafes or restaurants before continuing south to Busselton. Visiting Busselton Jetty is a 'must-do' experience in Busselton.
Extending almost 2km out over the protected waters or Geographe Bay, the heritage listed BUSSELTON JETTY is the longest timber jetty (pier) in the Southern Hemisphere. The new \$3.5 million dollar Underwater Observatory, now opened heralds the dawn of a new era in the life of the heritage-listed 137 year old jetty, establishing itself as one of Western Australia's major eco-tourism attractions. Next stop is the world-renowned Margaret River Wine Region.
Overnight: Seashells Yallingup (1bedroom Apartment / 2bedroom Apartment for 3A, 2A1C & 2A2C)

Day 05 - Margaret River / Pemberton / Margaret River

Continue your wine wander filling in the morning with galleries and attractions before a sumptuous winery lunch.
Travel through to Pemberton where majestic karri trees are dotted around picture-postcard wineries. Climb up the Gloucester Tree (probably Western Australia's most famous karri tree) which towers at 61 metres high above the forest surrounding Pemberton. Don't forget to try the region's delicacy, marron, a freshwater crayfish that provides a unique gourmet treat when enjoyed with a glass or two of final local wine; or bring home souvenirs from boutique attractions like lavender farms, cheese factories and chocolate factory.
Overnight: Seashells Yallingup (1bedroom Apartment / 2bedroom Apartment for 3A, 2A1C & 2A2C)

Day 06 - Margaret River / Perth / Singapore

Take the journey back to Perth passing through the Blackwood River Valley known for its cider and fruit wines.
Drop off your car at Perth airport for your afternoon flight back to Singapore.
